

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 27-2018

A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING APPRECIATION TO SUZI RUBIN FOR HER YEARS OF SERVICE TO THE COMMUNITY OF THE CITY OF MONROE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Suzi Rubin has served on City Council since January of 2004; and

WHEREAS, during her time on City Council she has served as Vice Mayor, a member of various Committees of Council, Monroe's representative on the Ohio-Kentucky-Indiana Regional Council of Governments, Monroe Area Community Improvement Corporation, and President of the Warren County Municipal League; and

WHEREAS, prior to her service on City Council she was a major influence on the creation of the Monroe Local School District; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Rubin has always volunteered her time for the betterment of our community outside of her duties as a member of City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Council hereby expresses its appreciation and dedication to Suzi Rubin for her many years of selfless hours she has given to improve the Monroe community.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to express its appreciation to Suzi Rubin at the earliest possible date and recognition shown that she has left a positive impact on the Monroe Community. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
