

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2020-17

AN ORDINANCE SUPPLEMENTING SECTION 286.13 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO ALLOW FOR FULL REFUNDS FOR CANCELLED RESERVATIONS IN EXIGENT CIRCUMSTANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 pandemic the City of Monroe had to cancel reservations of park shelters; and

WHEREAS, Council deems it to be fair to refund the deposits placed for said cancelled reservations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Section 286.13 of the Codified Ordinances is hereby supplemented to read as follows:

“The fee for reservation of a park shelter shall be \$25.00 per reservation and nonrefundable. Refunds shall only be approved by the City Manager or designee during exigent circumstances when the reservation is cancelled by the City of Monroe.”

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to allow for refunds due to the current exigent circumstances at the earliest possible date. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
