

**ORDINANCE NO. 2020-20**

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING THE PUBLIC SAFETY GRANT FUND AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF THE BALANCE OF THIS FUND TO THE GENERAL FUND.

WHEREAS, Council established the Public Safety Grant Fund through the adoption of Ordinance No. 2008-07 for training and equipment for emergency medical services; and

WHEREAS, additional grants were received in 2013 and 2014; and

WHEREAS, this fund has remained dormant since 2014 and has a cash balance of \$1,522.69; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Ohio Revised Code this fund can be closed and any balance transferred to the General Fund.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Public Safety Grant Fund is hereby closed and any remaining cash balance is hereby authorized to be transferred to the General Fund.

SECTION 2: This measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


