

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 43-2020

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE BUTLER COUNTY TAX INCENTIVE REVIEW COUNCIL OF MAY 21, 2020 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Community Reinvestment Area property tax abatements (CRAs), Tax Increment Finance Districts (TIFs), and Residential Improvement Districts (RIDs) must be reviewed annually by the relevant County Tax Incentive Review Council; and

WHEREAS, the Butler County Tax Incentive Review Council met on May 21, 2021, to review the CRA Agreement for Rivertown Brewery.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Council hereby accepts the recommendation of the Butler County Tax Incentive Review Council to renegotiate the rate/terms of the CRA Agreement for Rivertown Brewery.


