

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 51-2020

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL FINAL APPLICATION AND PARTICIPATION THEREOF BY THE CITY OF MONROE, OHIO, THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS PROGRAM FOR PY35/2021 FOR THE SOUTH UNION ROAD RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Monroe, Ohio has identified a need for certain public improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Water & Sewer Department, on behalf of the Warren County Commissioners, have also identified a need for certain public improvements within the same project area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Monroe, Ohio wishes to undertake such improvements by means of the Ohio Public Works Commission's (OPWC) Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Monroe has identified as their project as the South Union Road Reconstruction Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Jones Warner Consultants, Inc., the Project Engineer/Manager, is hereby authorized to act on behalf of the City by submitting a final application to the Warren County Sub-committee and OPWC.


SECTION 2: Upon grant award; formal acceptance and execution of any grant agreement will be made only by formal action of the City of Monroe Council and the City Manager.

SECTION 3: A cooperation agreement is in place between the City of Monroe, Ohio and the Warren County Water and Sewer Department outlining their roles and local share responsibilities and requirements.


SECTION 4: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to authorize the submission of the final application to stay within the guidelines of the Ohio Public Works Program. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
