

**EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2020-29**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND TRADE-IN OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15 authorizes the sale or trade-in of personal property not needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the sale and trade-in of the equipment described herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Council hereby authorizes the sale of a 1993 Ford 7740 (Motrim) - BD43028 as it is no longer needed for municipal purposes.

SECTION 2: Council hereby authorizes the trade-in of a 1993 Ford 4630 – BD55717, 1996 John Deere 5300 – LV5300D330645, 1997 John Deere 5400 – LV5400E543490, and 2000 John Deere 5410 – LV5410S341179 as they are no longer needed for municipal purposes.


SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to sell and trade-in the equipment at the earliest possible date so that the funds from the sale and the trade-in on new equipment can be utilized for necessary operations of the City. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.


