

**RESOLUTION NO. 43-2017**

A RESOLUTION SPECIFYING THE DATE AN ELECTION IS TO BE HELD ON THE QUESTION CONTAINED IN ORDINANCE NO. 2017-18 AND DIRECTING THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS OF BUTLER COUNTY AND WARREN COUNTY TO CONDUCT SAID ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the City of Monroe is required to file with the Board of Elections at least ninety days before the day of election a resolution specifying the date an election is to be held and directing the Board of Elections to conduct the election; and

WHEREAS, Council has adopted Ordinance No. 2017-18 providing for the submission of the question contained in said Ordinance to the electorate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Board of Elections of Butler County and Warren County are hereby directed to submit to the electorate the question contained in Ordinance No. 2017-13 to provide for a two percent levy on income tax to be allocated to the General Fund, Public Safety, and Capital Improvement Projects on the ballot for the November 7, 2017, election.


SECTION 2: The Clerk of Council is hereby directed to certify a copy of this Resolution to the Board of Elections of Butler County and Warren County on or before 4:00 p.m. on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2017.

SECTION 3: This measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage pursuant to Section 7.08(B)(4) of the Charter of the City of Monroe.
