

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 32-2018

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF MONROE AND LOGAN CREEK, LLC FOR THE MONROE BICENTENNIAL COMMONS TRANSITION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, after advertising and receipt of bids for the Monroe Bicentennial Commons Transition Project, it is determined that Logan Creek, LLC is the lowest and/or best bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract by and between the City of Monroe and Logan Creek, LLC for the Monroe Bicentennial Commons Transition Project in an amount not to exceed \$625,000. The terms and conditions of the contract shall be pursuant to the bid specifications received on June 1, 2018.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to proceed with this project at the earliest possible date so that the area is safe and can be utilized by the community. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
