

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 56-2018

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A THEN-AND-NOW CERTIFICATE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,367.57 TO THE TREASURER OF OHIO AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the purchase order for the Treasurer of Ohio did not have sufficient funds remaining for a new building on Salzman Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: A Then-and-Now Certificate in the amount of \$3,367.57 to the Treasurer of Ohio is hereby approved.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to authorize the Certificate at the earliest possible date to avoid any delay in paying for services rendered. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.


