

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 57-2018

A RESOLUTION AMENDING EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 07-2018 APPROVING BLANKET PURCHASE ORDERS AS RECOMMENDED BY THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE AND THE CITY MANAGER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's Purchasing Policies and Procedures, Council is required to approve blanket purchase orders; and

WHEREAS, due to the recent and anticipated development it is necessary to increase the amount for National Inspection Corporation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Council hereby approves the following blanket purchase orders:

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to establish the total not to exceed amount at the earliest possible date to provide for sufficient funds to cover expenditures. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.


