

**EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2018-06**

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF REAL PROPERTY TO BE USED FOR PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF JERRY COUCH BOULEVARD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, additional public right-of-way of approximately 0.125 acres and associated utility easements are needed in connection with the construction of Jerry Couch Boulevard.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The real property to be donated as indicated on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof is hereby accepted and dedicated as public right-of-way in connection with the construction of Jerry Couch Boulevard.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason to avoid any delay in the current project of the construction to the entrance to Monroe Bicentennial Commons. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
