

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 64-2018

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A THEN-AND-NOW CERTIFICATE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$9,345.29 TO MIDDLETOWN TRANSIT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a purchase order could not be opened because the final service cost had not been determined prior to receipt of the invoice.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: A Then-and-Now Certificate in the amount of \$9,345.29 to Middletown Transit is hereby approved.


