

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 67-2018

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING THE FILING OF A COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT APPLICATION FOR SIDEWALK, MULTI-USE PATH, AND ASSOCIATED CROSSWALK INFRASTRUCTURE FROM THE RESERVES OF MONROE CROSSINGS TO STATE ROUTE 4 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Butler County requires Council endorsement for the filing of a Community Development Block Grant application; and

WHEREAS, the grant being sought will help fund the multimodal connections from the Reserves at Monroe Crossings to Monroe Bicentennial Commons and the Great Miami River Trail.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Council hereby endorses the filing of a Community Development Block Grant application for sidewalk, multi-use path, and associated crosswalk infrastructure from the Reserves at Monroe Crossings to State Route 4.


