NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Council hereby accepts the following donations to be used exclusively for the purpose for which they were donated:

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to accept said donations at the earliest possible date so the funds can be utilized for the purposes set forth herein. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


