

**EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 07-2019**

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID SUBMITTED BY FORD DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE SOUTH MAIN STREET SIDEWALK EXTENSION PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, after advertisement and receipt of bids for the South Main Street Sidewalk Extension Project it was determined that the bid submitted by Ford Development Corporation was the lowest and/or best bid submitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The bid submitted by Ford Development Corporation on January 31, 2019, for the South Main Street Sidewalk Extension Project, is hereby accepted.


SECTION 2: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract by and between the City of Monroe and Ford Development Corporation for the South Main Street Sidewalk Extension Project according to the bidding documents submitted on January 31, 2019.

SECTION 3: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to proceed with the sidewalk extension at the earliest possible date to provide walking access on South Main Street. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.


