

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 10-2019

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BUTLER COUNTY ENGINEER'S OFFICE TO INCLUDE THE RELOCATION OF A CERTAIN CITY WATER MAIN WITH THE BIDDING OF A BUTLER COUNTY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, bids will be sought by the Butler County Engineer's office for the improvement to the intersection of Yankee Road and Hankins Road north to Carson Road; and

WHEREAS, the improvements include the relocation of approximately 500 feet of the City's water main; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to authorize the inclusion of the water main relocation in the Butler County Engineer's office bid.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Council hereby authorizes the inclusion of the City's water main relocation in the Butler County Engineer's bidding process for the improvements to the intersection of Yankee Road and Hankins Road north to Carson Road. Council further authorizes this inclusion in an amount not to exceed \$71,000.00.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to provide the within described authorization at the earliest possible date to avoid delay in the improvements. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
