

**EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 14-2019**

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A THEN-AND-NOW CERTIFICATE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,267.50 TO JONES-WARNER CONSULTANTS, INC. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council adopted Resolution No. 16-2018 accepting a proposal from Jones-Warner Consultants, Inc. in connection with the South Union Road Widening Project; and

WHEREAS, the proposal as part of Resolution No. 16-2018 was not to exceed \$39,950.00; and

WHEREAS, as the project progressed there was a need for unforeseen additional engineering services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: A Then-and-Now Certificate in the amount of \$7,267.50 to Jones-Warner Consultants, Inc. is hereby approved.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to authorize the payment of this amount at the earliest possible date so that payment for services rendered can be made in a timely manner. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.


