

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 06-2018

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE BUTLER COUNTY TAX INCENTIVE REVIEW COUNCIL OF NOVEMBER 8, 2017, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Community Reinvestment Area property tax abatements (CRAs) and Tax Increment Financing Districts (TIFs) must be reviewed annually by the relevant county Tax Incentive Review Council (TIRC); and


WHEREAS, the Butler County TIRC met on November 8, 2017, and recommended that the current CRAs and TIFs continue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Council hereby accepts the recommendation of the Butler County Tax Incentive Review Council to approve the continuation of the current Community Reinvestment Area property tax abatements and Tax Increment Finance Districts.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to act on the recommendation within 60 days of the recommendation. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.


