AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 2019-12 IN ITS ENTIRETY.

WHEREAS, Council deemed it in the best interest of the City of Monroe to regulate unsolicited materials; and

WHEREAS, Council adopted Ordinance No. 2019-12 regulating unsolicited materials; and

WHEREAS, due to a decision of the United State Court of Appeals for the Sixth District, Council desires to repeal Ordinance No. 2019-12 and adopt new regulations in light of this decision.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Ordinance No. 2019-12 is hereby repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2: This measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.


