

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 49-2019

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF MONROE AND BARRETT PAVING MATERIALS, INC. FOR THE 2019 PAVEMENT RESURFACING PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, bids were advertised and received for the 2019 Pavement Resurfacing Project; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to accept and authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the lowest and/or best bidder after bidding according to law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1: After advertisement and bidding, the bid submitted by Barrett Paving Materials, Inc. is hereby accepted and determined to be the lowest and/or best bidder for the 2019 Pavement Resurfacing Project.

SECTION 2: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement by and between the City of Monroe and Barrett Paving Materials, Inc. for the 2019 Pavement Resurfacing Project in an amount not to exceed \$427,033.84 pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the bid specifications submitted on September 20, 2019.

SECTION 3: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to proceed with the project at the earliest possible date so that it is completed in 2019. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
