

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2016-34

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2016-29 TO INCREASE THE AMOUNT TRANSFERRED FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE POLICE LAW ENFORCEMENT FUND, FIRE-1989 LEVY FUND, AND GO BOND RETIREMENT FUND, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to accurately reflect the amounts necessary to be transferred; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to specifically approve certain transfers in order to provide a more accurate reporting of the financial situation of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1: Section 1 of Emergency Ordinance No. 2016-29 is hereby repealed and amended to read as follows:
