

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 40-2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT WITH KINSTLE STERLING/WESTERN STAR TRUCK CENTER FOR TWO SNOW PLOW TRUCKS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, in order to begin a rotation schedule for the snow plow trucks Council desires to proceed with the lease of two snow plow trucks.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a lease agreement with Kinstle Sterling/Western Star Truck Center in the monthly amount of \$62,791.47 for five years.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to order the vehicles at the earliest possible date prior to the inclement weather. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
