

**EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 47-2016**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE PROPOSAL FROM RVP ENGINEERING FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES RELATED TO THE DESIGN OF A SIDEWALK CONNECTION ALONG SOUTH MAIN STREET TO MONROE COMMUNITY PARK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a sidewalk connection from the City Building/Downtown Area to Monroe Community Park has been a long term goal; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to proceed with the engineering drawings for the sidewalk connection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is authorized to accept the proposal from RVP Engineering for professional engineering services related to the design of a sidewalk connection along South Main Street to Monroe Community Park in an amount not to exceed \$23,240.00.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to proceed with the project at the earliest possible date to allow safe pedestrian and bicycle traffic to the Monroe Community Park. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
