

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 56-2017

A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE BID AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BANSAL CONSTRUCTING, INC. FOR THE HOLLYTREE DRIVE AT CLARK BOULEVARD TRAFFIC SIGNAL PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, bids were sought and received for the Hollytree Drive at Clark Boulevard Traffic Signal Project; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to award the bid and enter into a contract with the lowest and/or best bidder.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1: Council hereby awards the bid submitted by Bansal Construction, Inc. in amount not to exceed \$211,592.35 for the Hollytree Drive at Clark Boulevard Traffic Signal Project.

SECTION 2: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Bansal Construction, Inc. pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the bid documents submitted on December 2, 2016.




