

**EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2014-03**

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTIONS 236.05 AND 236.06 OF THE ADMINISTRATION CODE OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council establishes positions, wage, and salary ranges for the entire City through an ordinance adopted pursuant to the Charter of the City of Monroe; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to amend the positions of Income Tax Commissioner and Income Tax Clerk, now known as Income Tax Auditor, from classified to unclassified.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Sections 236.05 and 236.06 of the Administration Code of the Codified Ordinances is hereby repealed in their entirety.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, and further for the reason that Council desires to repeal these sections at the earliest possible date to fill the upcoming vacancy of Income Tax Commissioner. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.


