

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2014-10

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND TRADE IN OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15 authorizes the sale and trade in of personal property not needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the sale and trade in of certain items valued at one thousand dollars or more.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Council hereby authorizes the sale of the following personal property not needed for municipal purposes:


- Woods Batwing Cutter
- John Deere 850 Tractor
- Reach Arm Mowing Tractor
- Tow Behind Street Sweeper
- International Loadstar 1700 1976 Fire Truck
- Army Duce and Trailer
- 1986 GMC 7000 Series Dump Truck
- 1991 GMC 3500 Dump Truck
- 1992 GMC 2500 Truck with Utility Bed
- 2001 Dodge 2500 Pickup Truck

SECTION 2: Council hereby authorizes the trade in of a Big Tex 70PI-18 trailer towards the purchase of a larger trailer.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to authorize the sale of the personal property at the earliest possible date so the proceeds can be used for other needed items. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
