

**EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2014-29**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE TRADE IN OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 721.15 authorizes the trade in of personal property not needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the trade in of certain items valued at one thousand dollars or more.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1: Council hereby authorizes the trade in of the following personal property not needed for municipal purposes:

1991 GMC Topkick  
1996 Chevrolet Kodiak  
2001 International




