

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2015-27

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE NO. 2015-03 TO REDUCE THE AMOUNT TRANSFERRED FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE STREET FUND AND AUTHORIZE A TRANSFER FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO THE STORM WATER FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to accurately reflect the amounts necessary to be transferred; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to specifically approve certain transfers in order to provide a more accurate reporting of the financial situation of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1: Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2015-03 is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows:


