

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE 2015-39

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF MONROE AND RDT CONCEPTS FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THREE DISPATCH CONSOLES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, bids were advertised and received for three dispatch consoles; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to accept and authorize the City Manager to enter into a contract with the lowest and/or best bidder after bidding according to law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1: After advertisement and bidding, the bid submitted by RDT Concepts is hereby accepted and determined to be the lowest and/or best bidder for three dispatch consoles.

SECTION 2: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement by and between the City of Monroe and RDT Concepts for three dispatch consoles in an amount not to exceed \$52,855.00 pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the bid specifications submitted on November 9, 2015.

SECTION 3: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to authorize this contract at the earliest possible date and prior to the expiration of the bid. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
