

EMERGENCY ORDINANCE NO. 2016-08

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF CERTAIN PERSONAL PROPERTY NO LONGER NEEDED FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code 721.15 authorizes the sale of personal property not needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the sale of certain items valued at one thousand dollars or more.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Council hereby authorizes the sale of the 1988 Ford F-700 with a Pitman Aerial lift of 40 feet, VIN number 1FDWK75P9JVA38197, not needed for municipal purposes.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to sell the personal property at the earliest possible date so the revenue can be used toward the purchase of a replacement. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
