WHEREAS, a purchase order was not opened due to the fact that the project was already in process when the additional concrete work was realized.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: A Then-and-Now Certificate in the amount of \$3,674.00 to L. J. DeWeese Co. Inc. is hereby approved.


