WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's Purchasing Policies and Procedures, Council is required to approve blanket purchase orders.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1: Council hereby approves the following blanket purchase order:

VENDOR	AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED	DEPARTMENTS AFFECTED
National Inspection Corporation	\$200,000	Development

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to establish the total not to exceed amount at the earliest possible date to provide for sufficient funds to cover expenditures. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
