

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 10-2015

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS FROM THE OHIO DEVELOPMENT SERVICES AGENCY FOR CONSULTING SERVICES TO IMPROVE THE WORK ORDER PROCESS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ACCEPTANCE OF SAID GRANT FUNDS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City applied for and received approval of grant funds for consulting services to apply Lean and Six Sigma principles to the work order process in the Department of Public Works.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The grant funds from the Ohio Development Services Agency in the amount of \$50,000 is hereby accepted.


SECTION 2: The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute any and all documents required for acceptance of said grant funds, including the payment of not to exceed \$6,000 in matching funds.

SECTION 3: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to accept the grant funds to improve efficiency in the work order process at the earliest possible date. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
