

**EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 12-2016**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE LOWEST AND/OR BEST BIDDER FOR THE TURF MAINTENANCE OF THE I-75 INTERCHANGE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, bids were advertised for and received, according to law, for the turf maintenance of the I-75 Interchange; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the lowest and/or best bidder after bidding according to law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1: After advertisement and bidding, Olympic Lawns, also known as Complete Lawncare Specialists, is hereby determined to be the lowest and/or best bidder.

SECTION 2: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement by and between the City of Monroe and Olympic Lawns, also known as Complete Lawncare Specialists, for the turf maintenance of the I-75 Interchange in an amount not to exceed thirty seven thousand four hundred fifty five dollars (\$37,455.00) per year pursuant to the terms and conditions set forth in the bid specifications submitted on February 18, 2016.

SECTION 3: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to enter into an agreement at the earliest possible date to optimize the City's staff time for other services provided by the Department of Public Works. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
