

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 18-2015

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A THEN-AND-NOW CERTIFICATE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,750.00 TO CROUSE CONSULTING & THERAPY SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the amount of preparing a Transitional Work Program was unknown until receipt of the invoice; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation will reimburse the City for 75% of the cost of preparing the Transitional Work Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: A Then-and-Now Certificate in the amount of \$5,750.00 to Crouse Consulting & Therapy Services is hereby approved.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desire to approve the Certificate at the earliest possible date so that payment for services rendered can be made in a timely manner. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
