

**EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 18-2016**

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE WARREN COUNTY TAX INCENTIVE REVIEW COUNCIL OF MARCH 14, 2016, AS FURTHER DESCRIBED HEREIN, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Community Reinvestment Area property tax abatements and Tax Increment Finance Districts must be reviewed annually by the relevant County Tax Incentive Review Council; and

WHEREAS, the Warren County Tax Incentive Review Council met on March 14, 2016 and made the within described recommendations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Council hereby accept the following recommendations of the Warren County Tax Incentive Review Council:

“Find all CRA agreements in the City of Monroe to be in compliance and to recommend their continuation.”

“Find Monroe's TIF districts to be in compliance and to recommend their continuation.”

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to accept the recommendations within 60 days of the date of Warren County's recommendations pursuant to law. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
