

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 20-2015

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE BID AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FORD DEVELOPMENT CORP. FOR THE CARSON ROAD IMPROVEMENT PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, bids were sought for improvements to Carson Road from South Main Street to South Sands Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to accept the lowest and/or best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept the bid submitted by Ford Development Corp. and enter into an agreement for the Carson Road Improvement Project in an amount not to exceed \$979,006.28 pursuant to the terms and conditions of the bid submitted on April 30, 2015.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to proceed with the improvement project at the earliest possible date to limit the impact the project may have on school bus traffic. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
