

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 22-2015

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE AND RECEIVE BIDS FOR THE 2015 RESURFACING PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, certain streets and areas have been identified as in need of resurfacing and storm culvert; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to advertise so that the improvements can be made as early as possible.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for the 2015 Resurfacing Program. The 2015 Resurfacing Program includes the following improvements:

Resurfacing of Valleybrook Drive, portion of Old Orchard Lane, portion of Meadowood Drive, walking path at Monroe Crossings Park, and the parking lot at the Fire Station located at State Route 4; and the replacement of a storm culvert under Valleybrook Drive.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to advertise so that the improvements can be completed at the earliest possible date. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
