WHEREAS, Council desires to proceed with the 2014 Resurfacing Program for improvement to the within described streets.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for the 2014 Resurfacing Program for Doverdale Drive from Wexford Drive to Fox Run Place, Woodland Court from Oaklawn Drive to the end of the cul-de-sac, and Yankee Road from the Lemon Township maintenance limit to Todhunter Road.


