

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 30-2016

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A NEXT GENERATION INTERNSHIP GRANT FROM THE OHIO CITY/COUNTY MANAGEMENT ASSOCIATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Monroe and the City of Springboro are working jointly for the employment of an intern; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded a grant to pay for a portion of the salary of the intern.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The Next Generation Internship Grant from the Ohio City/County Management Association is hereby accepted to reimburse the City up to 50% of the salary paid to the intern to a maximum of \$2,000.


SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to accept said grant at the earliest possible date to avoid any delay in receiving reimbursement. 
