

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 38-2014

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THEN-AND-NOW CERTIFICATE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$11,123.83 TO FROST BROWN TODD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the amount of professional legal services provided by Frost Brown Todd is unknown from time-to-time and a purchase order was not opened prior to receipt of the invoice.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: A Then-and-Now Certificate in the amount of \$11,123.83 to Frost Brown Todd is hereby approved.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to authorize the payment of this amount at the earliest possible date so that payment for services rendered can be made in a timely manner. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.


