A RESOLUTION SUPPLEMENTING EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 04-2014 APPROVING BLANKET PURCHASE ORDERS AS RECOMMENDED BY THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE AND THE CITY MANAGER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City's Purchasing Policies and Procedures, Council is required to approve blanket purchase orders.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Council hereby approves the following blanket purchase orders:


