

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 41-2014

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING A FM GLOBAL FIRE PREVENTION GRANT FOR THE PURCHASE OF FIRE PRE-PLANNING SOFTWARE AND A LAPTOP AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Monroe applied for and was granted a FM Global Fire Prevention Grant for the purchase of fire pre-planning software and a laptop; and


WHEREAS, Council desires to accept said grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Council hereby accepts the FM Global Fire Prevention Grant in the amount of two thousand nine hundred eighty one dollars (\$2,981) for the purchase of fire pre-planning software and a laptop.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to accept said grant at the earliest possible date so that the grant funds can be utilized for the benefit of fire services. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
