

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 44-2015

A RESOLUTION AMENDING EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 28-2015 TO AUTHORIZE THE CORRECT AMOUNT FOR THE UNION ROAD RETAINING WALL PROJECT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council authorized an agreement with Rack and Ballauer for the Union Road Retaining Wall through the adoption of Emergency Resolution No. 28-2015; and

WHEREAS, Emergency Resolution No. 28-2015 contained a typographical error in the amount of the accepted bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Section 1 of Emergency Resolution No. 28-2015 is hereby amended to read as follows:

“SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to accept the bid submitted by Rack and Ballauer Excavating and enter into an agreement for the Union Road Retaining Wall Project in an amount not to exceed \$460,505.00 pursuant to the terms and conditions of the bid submitted on May 7, 2015.”

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to authorize the correct amount at the earliest possible date to avoid any delay in paying for the within described project. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
