

**EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 57-2014**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE AND RECEIVE BIDS FOR HIGHWAY ROCK SALT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City is a member of the Southwest Ohio Purchasers for Government (SWOP4G); and

WHEREAS, the bids received through the SWOP4G limit the amount of highway rock salt member jurisdictions can purchase at a significant increase in cost per ton than last year; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to seek bids in the event additional salt is needed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for highway rock salt.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to allow for sufficient time to seek bids to allow additional resources for the purchase of highway rock salt should the need arise. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
