

**EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 66-2014**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF MONROE AND ENTERPRISE FLEET MANAGEMENT FOR THE LEASING AND MANAGEMENT OF NON-FIRST RESPONDER FLEET VEHICLES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, in connection with energy savings options, Council desires to proceed with the leasing and management of non-first responder fleet vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement by and between the City of Monroe and Enterprise Fleet Management for the leasing and management of non-first responder fleet vehicles at an annual cost of \$170,707.00.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to recognize the energy savings at the earliest possible date. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
