

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 67-2014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF MONROE AND AERO-MARK FOR THE RE-STRIPING OF CERTAIN STREETS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, after bids received according to law, Aero-Mark is determined to be the lowest and/or best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:


SECTION 1: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement by and between the City of Monroe and Aero-Mark for the re-striping of the following streets at a cost not to exceed \$20,836.20:

Todhunter Road (Britton Lane to State Route 4)
Lebanon Street (Gallaher Road to South Main Street)
Garver Road (Baker Drive to New Garver Road)
Salzman Road (from new pavement to State Route 63)
South Main Street (Mound Cemetery to Carson Road)

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to proceed with the re-striping prior to the inclement weather. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
