

**EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 69-2014**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF MONROE AND THE OHIO PATROLMEN'S BENEVOLENT ASSOCIATION (PATROL OFFICERS), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, negotiations between the City of Monroe and the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association (Patrol Officers), have been ongoing; and

WHEREAS, as a result of said negotiations the parties have reached an agreement.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a Collective Bargaining Agreement by and between the City of Monroe and the Ohio Patrolmen's Benevolent Association (Patrol Officers), pursuant to the terms and conditions he deems appropriate and necessary in the best interest of the City.

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to enter into said agreement at the earliest possible date in order to maintain, insure and/or increase the general efficiency of the police department and the existing harmonious relationship between the patrol officers of the police department and the City of Monroe. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.
