

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 74-2014

A RESOLUTION AMENDING EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 48-2014 TO INCREASE THE BLANKET PURCHASE ORDER AMOUNT FOR NATIONAL INSPECTION CORPORATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council approved a blanket purchase order for National Inspection Corporation; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that additional budget will be required to cover the remainder of the year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: Section 1 of Emergency Resolution No. 48-2014 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to provide for additional budget to cover the remainder of the year. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.


