

EMERGENCY RESOLUTION NO. 78-2014

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE BID AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF MONROE AND L. J. DEWESE CO., INC. FOR CONCRETE WORK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council adopted Emergency Resolution No. 52-2014 declaring the necessity of repairing certain sidewalks, curbs, gutters, and driveway aprons; and

WHEREAS, Council desires to proceed with the unfinished repairs referred to in Emergency Resolution No. 52-2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MONROE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1: The bid submitted by L. J. DeWeese Co., Inc. in the amount of \$62,983.00 is hereby accepted.

SECTION 2: The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement by and between the City of Monroe and L. J. DeWeese Co., Inc. pursuant to the bid specifications received on October 30, 2014.

SECTION 3: This measure is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare and further for the reason that Council desires to proceed with the improvements prior to inclement weather. Therefore, this measure shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage.


